Important advances have taken place in 2009:

- technical investigations have well progressed thanks to workshops with an active participation of multiple experts world-wide.
- the organization of the SPL study inside CERN has improved. Publications, data storage and information on meetings are stored in a structured fashion.
- European countries have decided to build ESS in Lund.
- additional resources have been secured (DOE, French in-kind).
- the “final” version of the MoU for the SPL Collaboration is available. Writing of addenda is started and signatures are about to begin. The first CB will take place this afternoon.
- declared interest of additional partners to join the SPL collaboration.
